Gormanston Park

21st & 22nd February 2026

Introduction

This year's VLY Championships will be played at Gormanston College over the weekend of 21st & 22nd February 2026.

The intention of the Championships is to provide a more social environment for up-and-coming teams to play against other teams of a similar standard.

This year sees 43 teams taking part, across four competitions – two for men and two for women, with each competition played to a conclusion in a single day.

The key to the success of this weekend is for all teams to keep matches moving, so we would ask everyone taking part to work on this basis. Last year's championships ran to time on both days, so a big act to follow this year!

Timetable & General Info


Some key information for noting ahead of the Championships.

- The event is being hosted by Volleyball Ireland at Gormanston College.
- Teams must be present at least 30 minutes before the scheduled start time of their first match on each day.
- Prior to taking to the court, teams must complete player registrations – this can be done by each player or, preferably, by the team contact.
- Match balls are provided for use in matches only.
- First Aid coverage will be provided by *EFast*. In the event of any injury issues during the event, VLY will defer to any advice provided by *EFast*.
- The college will be providing a limited café service throughout both days, so you may wish to bring additional refreshments as required.
- The full match schedule, appointments, results and tables can be found on the Tournify app, which we would encourage teams to download prior to the event.
- Teams should look like a team when playing and, as a minimum, playing shirts should all be of the same design and colour (except Liberos). All shirts must be numbered with a different number.
- As matches are untimed – teams should be ready to take the court at the conclusion of the preceding match.
- We would ask that at the end of each match, you ensure the bench area is cleared of bottles, clothing etc, given the short turnaround time before the next match. **Please leave the court area as you would expect to find it before each of your matches.**
- When leaving the venue after a team's last match of that day, we would ask you take all litter home with you – please don't assume that someone else will tidy up after you.
- No alcohol or smoking is permitted at the venue.
- No photography is permitted throughout the event. Anyone who wishes to attend as an official photographer for a team must sign in each day at the tournament desk.
- Please remember that with over 40 teams taking part across the weekend, there are inevitably going to be down periods, where your team will have a wait to play their next match. During those down periods, we may ask teams to cover a scoring or refereeing shift at short notice, so would appreciate your assistance with this.

Venue and Location Information

The VLY Championships are being held at Gormanston College, Co Meath. This venue has been used for a number of years and has four courts that will be used throughout the weekend.

- a. **Getting here:** The College is located 5 mins from Junction 7 of the M1. The Eircode is **K32 NH30** and the Sports Hall is located at the north end of the car park, adjacent to the running track area.

Player Registration

Teams need to confirm their squad list to VLY, on the relevant form, by close of business on 17th February. We would ask teams to respect this deadline given the need to organise the paperwork for the 40+ teams taking part across the weekend. Playing squads can be registered either on a standalone form or through JustGo, by allocating players to Championship teams, but all players must have a non-league licence attached to their JustGo profile, as a minimum.

Teams are asked to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the start of their first match on each day, in order to complete their player registrations.

For each player listed on the squad list, the tournament supervisor needs to see a piece of photo ID that correlates a head & shoulders photo of the player with their name, just as would happen in NL matches. Any player who cannot meet this requirement will not be able to take part in the Championships. Additional spot checks may take place throughout the weekend to ensure continued compliance with this rule.

For each match, teams can play a maximum squad of 14, but there can be no interchanges during the match between anyone in that 14 and any other player in the above-named squad. Those additional players will be asked to support from the balcony above the courts.

For the competition finals, 14's will need to be listed on the official match scoresheet.

Competition Formats

The formats for each of the four competitions are as follows:

Men's Junior – 11 teams

Teams will play in a single 11-team group and play a match against four of the other teams in the group.

At the end of the group stage, i.e. when all teams have played four matches, the top two teams in the group progress to the Semi-Finals and will be joined by the winners of crossover play-off games between the next four teams – 3rd will play 6th and 4th will play 5th.

Men's Intermediate – 10 teams

Teams have been drawn into 2 round-robin groups of 5 teams.

At the end of the group stages, the two group winners progress to the Semi-Finals and will be joined by the winners of crossover play-off games between the teams finishing 2nd and 3rd in each group.

Women's Junior – 16 teams

Teams have been drawn into 4 round-robin groups of 4 teams.

At the end of the group stages, the four group winners will progress direct to the quarter-finals. The teams finishing 2nd and 3rd in each group will play a crossover play-off match, with the winners of those matches also progressing to the quarter-finals.

Women's Intermediate – 6 teams

Teams will play in a single 6-team group and play all the other teams in the group.

At the end of the group stage, the top team in the group progresses direct to the Final and will be joined by the winner of a play-off game between the teams finishing 2nd and 3rd.

Details of the draws for each competition are found in Appendix 1.

Format for each match

Repeating the format from last year, each match (except for Finals) will be played over one set, with the first to 25, with two clear points. If scores reach 24-24 it will be the first team to move two points clear. If the scores reach 27-27, then the next point will decide the winner of the match.

Each team will be entitled to call one time out per set.

Substitutions are permitted, although any interchanges of players must take place with the knowledge and consent of the referee(s).

Teams will earn three points in the group table for each match won. At the end of the group stages, positions will be decided based on group points. Positions will be decided as follows:

- Most group points,
- Points difference (on the court) in all group matches,
- Head-to-head result(s) between teams tied,
- Points scored in all matches.

If a tie is broken as above, the tie-breaks continue from that point to break any subsequent ties. If the above fails to break a tie, then positions will be decided by the drawing of lots.

Finals will be played as best of three set matches, with standard National League competition rules applying.

Tournify is our tournament software platform, and a link is [here](#), which outlines the match schedule, groups and format. This will be updated in the build up to the event, so we would ask teams to monitor the schedule in the days prior to the event. Tournify is available to download on both the Google Play and Apple Store.

Timekeeping & Scheduling

Each competition is being run from start to finish in a single day. As matches are untimed and played as a single set match, this means that some matches may finish more quickly than others which, by definition, means that the start times on Tournify can only be estimates. On both days in 2025, matches ran to schedule and, periodically, were running ahead of time!

What this means, in practical terms, is that if a preceding match finishes early, and the two teams playing next are on court and referees and scorekeepers are available, there is no reason for the match not to begin sooner than might be advertised on Tournify.

When tournaments reach the knockout stages, VI reserves the right to relocate matches to different courts stated on Tournify if a preceding match is overrunning.

Every effort will be made to ensure that Semi-Finals and Finals start at the advertised time, but we need the help of every team to make this possible.

Delays and overruns mostly happen because teams aren't ready to play, or teams expected to score or referee aren't in place (or have forgotten). If teams are ready to play, but there is no referee, tell us and we'll get a referee to you. The competitions are a long day for everyone, be it players, referees, coaches, spectators and staff and, with that in mind, we encourage you all to do your best to keep matches flowing.

Referees & Scorekeepers

On most occasions, two referees will officiate each match, along with one scorekeeper, although there may be games where only one referee is available. Scorekeeping will be done by teams involved in the competition, and these will be appointed through Tournify. Most scoring appointments will involve teams who lose a match staying to score the next one on that court.

When we reach the knockout stages, we would beg your indulgence and ask that if you are knocked out of a competition prior to the Semi-Finals, that you stay behind to offer to score one last match.

At the end of each match, we would ask that the scoresheet be returned to the tournament desk asap by the winning team, so that the result can be uploaded to Tournify promptly – this is particularly important towards the end of the group stages, as play-off rounds cannot be populated until all group match results have been inputted to Tournify.

Conduct

The Championships are a recreational competition, with an emphasis on playing in the spirit of friendship and respect. In taking part in the competition, all players and coaches agree to abide by the VLY Code of Conduct. Teams are also responsible for the conduct of their spectators/supporters and, in the event of spectators becoming unruly, the team who they are supporting will be asked to talk to those visitors to moderate their behaviour.

Volleyball Ireland adopts a zero-tolerance approach to abuse of or by players, referees, supporters and the venue and, as such, VI's tournament supervisor reserves the right to immediately disqualify any team(s) who fail to respect the competition and its values.
